Jay Smith

is a noted evangelist and apologist to Muslims at *Speakers' Corner* in London. Jay has a Master's

degree in Islamic studies from Fuller Theological Seminary and is currently working on a Ph.D. at London School of Theology. Jay is an expert in Christian-Muslim Apologetics, having worked with Muslims for [over] 23 years. He is famous for his unique evangelistic ministry. Every weekend he leads dozens of Christians to the Speakers Corner in Hyde Park in London, where they meet with hundreds of Muslims face to face, to make friends, answer tough questions, debate the latest research and ideas, and share their faith. Smith heads up Hyde Park Christian Fellowship, and emphasizes the use of *Polemics* with Muslims, over apologetics.

Majed El-Shafie

is the president and founder of One Free World International (OFWI), an international human rights organization which advocates for religious minorities. Rev. El

Shafie was born as a Muslim in Cairo, Egypt. After converting to Christianity, he was arrested in 1998 and taken to the Abu Zaabel prison in Cairo, where he was severely tortured for 7 days. After receiving the death penalty, he managed to escape Egypt by driving a stolen jet-ski from Taba in Sinai to nearby Eilat, Israel. Rev. El Shafie was arrested in Israel, but eventually released through the assistance of the United Nations and additional organizations, which helped him to obtain political asylum in Canada. In 2002, he settled in Canada, and in 2006 became a Canadian citizen. Rev. El Shafie has been the subject of an international award winning documentary entitled the "Freedom Fighter". In 2012, Rev. El Shafie received the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal. This



man has a great love for all people but particularly those who are discriminated against, tortured or even martyred for their faith.




Usama Dakdok was born in Egypt and raised in a Christian home as the son of a Baptist pastor. He became a Christian at the age of eleven. Usama

learned about Islam in school because it was, and still is, a mandatory subject. To further his knowledge of Islam, he studied Islamic law in college. Today Usama resides in Venice, FL and is the President of "**The Straight Way of Grace Ministries.**" Usama regularly teaches seminars revealing the growing Islam effect on the world. He was concerned when he came to the United States in 1992 to see Mosques being built all over the United States. Some of his regular seminar titles are:

- Creation and Science According to Islam.
- Is the Qur'an Infallible?

He is the host of a radio broadcast "Revealing Islam." Usama is also a published author of "**The Generous Qur'an,**" An Accurate, Modern English Translation of the Qur'an, Islam's Holiest Book. Usama is a gifted teacher who will open your eyes to the encroaching nature of radical Islam and its spread throughout the world.
